Please note the following information from the Cincinnati Boychoir:

*Auditions and initial rehearsals for new training choir boys will take place **Tuesday, January 4, 2011, 6:15 – 8:00pm** at the Boychoir facility. It is important that your son arrives early (by 6:00). Your son does not need to prepare a vocal solo for his audition. He may dress comfortably. **He should bring this letter with him.***

It is recommended that you call to confirm your audition ahead of time (513) 396-7664.

Please understand that attendance at rehearsals and concerts is required. The tuition fee, which provides approximately 20% of the organization's income, is currently \$225 per semester + a \$25 refundable jacket deposit. There are two semesters per school year. Financial assistance is available.
